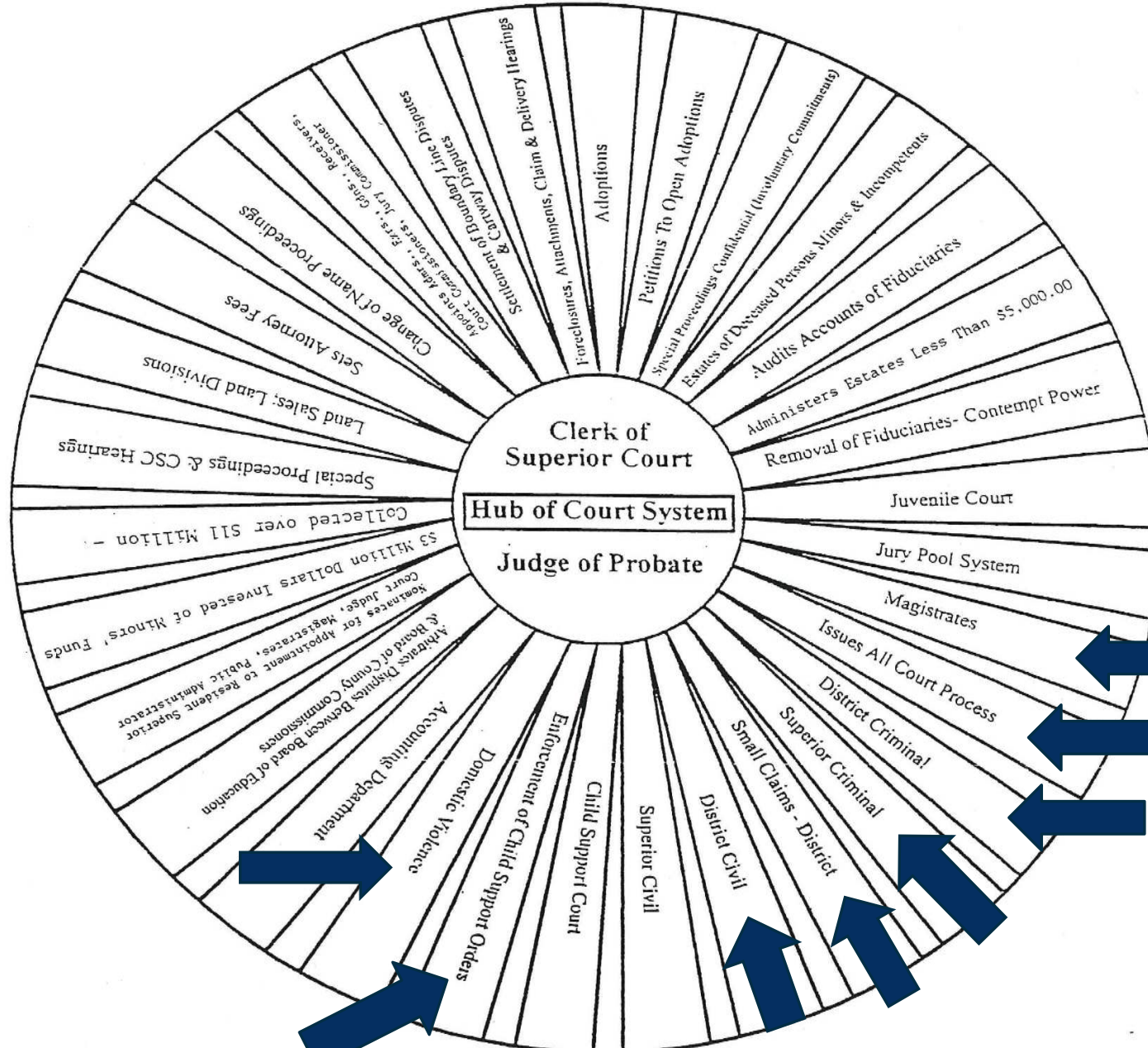

- ▶ This proposed process to complete a 50B, by the Victim at the time of the incident will increase Officer and Victim safety. As it allows for a major reduction in the time it takes to complete the paperwork involved with processing a 50B.
- ▶ It also can be utilized for other process that the Clerk of Court is responsible for.
